### OVERALL OBJECTIVES:

- 1: To contribute to economic integration of Moldova into EU space through its regional and cross-border cooperation development in the framework of the European Neighbourhood Policy.

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

- 1: To enrich the existing curricula at ASEM in the field of the EU economic studies;
- 2: To increase knowledge of the target groups in EU's economic and trade policies and to elevate lifelong learning in Moldova.
- 3: To enhance visibility of scientific resources and results in the field of European economic integration studies.
- 4: To promote EU innovation and research policy and to contribute to the complementarity between education-research-innovation in Moldova.
- 5: To disseminate tailor-made information about European economic integration to a wider public in Moldova.

### INTEGRA PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

- 1: Teaching activities: Master and Summer school courses;
- 2: Deliverables: Project's brochure & website, Newsletter, Working papers, Forum's publication, International Journal, training materials.

### IMPACT:

- 1: Increased knowledge of the target groups in Moldova on the progress achieved towards economic integration of Moldova into EU space within ENP.
- 2: Improved understanding of the EU economic policy and increased knowledge on the importance, impacts and benefits of the EU trade policy for Moldova by the target groups.
- 3: Better advised and informed target groups on EU policies towards Moldova in the field of education and science.

### METHODOLOGY:

#### A) Learning methods:

- Teaching of university courses will be realised within existing Master programmes at the ASEM (point F.2.1). The courses will address traditional student cohorts and will be substantially based on, besides the traditional ex cathedra lectures, the seminar classes, case studies, discussions, oral presentations of certain topics etc. In addition, courses will use the technique of educational debate, preparing target groups to deliberate on certain issues and critically assess their own point of views.
- Teaching of training courses will be realised within "EU.ACADEMY" Summer School (point F2.4). The professional training courses will be addressed to not-traditional learners (professional groups) and traditional students as well but more interactive teaching methods will be used for both cases, based on the knowledge and skills that learners will bring to the classrooms. The students will get and give direct feedback on the courses topics thus transparent and high-profile quality assurance system will be performed.

#### B) Interactive events:

- International Forum "TRIANGLE" will represent will have a scientific-practical approach and will involve EU and national experts. It will be realised as a combination of expert's speeches, interactive presentations of case studies, best practices and drafting of recommendation. Each Forum will be finalised by the publication.

#### C) Multidisciplinary synergies of the project itself as well as its activities and deliverables will allow for the connection of various aspects of EU integration topics. Accordingly, the project's topics will be addressed not only from political, legal and human rights perspectives but will also take into consideration other relevant aspects (trade, educational & science, sociological, cultural, moral and ethical) when applicable.

#### D) Openness to civil society. The project's activities are dedicated to the development and strengthening of the cooperation between academic/research and civil society with main focus on youth people. The representatives of the civil society will take active part in the project activities during the whole period of its realisation.
